- 1. How many weeks are there in a year? 52 weeks
- 2. How many days after in the different months of the year? 30 days has September, April, June and November. All the rest have 31, except February which has 28 each year and 29 in a leap year.
- 3. How many days are in a fortnight? 14 days
- 4. What time is 3pm on a 24 hour clock? 15.00
- 5. How many months are in a year? 12 months
- 6. How many hours are there in a day? 24 hours
- 7. How many days are there in a year? 365 days
- 8. What is a 4 sided shape called? Quadrilateral
- 9. What is a 5 sided shape called? Pentagon
- 10. What is a 6 sided shape called? Hexagon
