GCSE and A-LEVEL Art and Photography Exhibition


On Thursday 6th July, we had our annual GCSE and A-LEVEL Art and Photography exhibition.

It was a wonderful evening, where students could talk through their work, their inspirations and their themes of their pieces, which included their initial ideas, right up to their final pieces.


It was a fabulous evening. We are so proud of the journey our students have been on.
